- Bottles, Jars & Cans
- Milk & Juice Cartons
- Foils

Recycle This— but not in your Blue Bin

- **Batteries (household only, no auto batteries)** – Drop off at any Wegmans, OCRRA's transfer stations, or Community Collection Center (C3). For hours and directions visit www.OCRRA.org.
- **Books** – Bring to OCRRA's Community Collection Center (C3) at 6085 Court Street Road. Visit www.OCRRA.org for hours and directions.
- **Plastic bags** – Take clean bags to your local grocery store for recycling.
- **Fluorescent bulbs (household only, no bulbs from businesses)** – Recycle at most local ACE and True Value Hardware stores or bring to OCRRA's Community Collection Center (C3) at 6085 Court Street Road. Visit www.OCRRA.org for a list of participating hardware stores or C3 hours and directions.
- **Styrofoam peanuts and bubble wrap** – Some UPS stores will reuse them. Call before dropping off material.

Trash This!

PAPER

- Egg cartons (paper or Styrofoam)
- Paper towels and tissues
- Paper plates and cups
- Metallic paper (e.g. metallic wrapping paper and greeting cards)

CONTAINERS

- Plastic containers that are NOT bottles, including whipped cream containers, margarine tubs, frozen food trays, to-go food containers, plastic cups, yogurt containers, garden pots, buckets, etc.
- Any container that held pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, motor oil, anti-freeze, etc.
- Glass that is NOT a bottle or jar, including broken glass, window glass, drinking glasses, etc.
- Latex paint cans (dry out and remove lids)
- Styrofoam
- Ceramic plates and mugs
- Light bulbs; except household fluorescent bulbs. Take them to the Community Collection Center (C3).
